## Heraklion (Crete), 2<sup>nd</sup> - 4<sup>th</sup> March 2016

- 1. João Duarte has been elected as new WG2 leader and is taking over the tasks of Marta Perez-Gussinye.
- 2. A draft of the writing proposal should be created within the next 2-3 months and by the end of this year a final paper should be finalized (see Annex "FLOW System").
- 3. As it had already been agreed amongst MC members: participation at two workshops in the near future

- 4.
